## Bye-law No. 01

### PLAYING DRESS CODE

**Club Members while playing at Lostock are required to conform to the Club's Dress Code. Players must wear recognised tennis clothing. Specific examples of acceptable/unacceptable wear are given below:**

#### ACCEPTABLE

\*Tennis specific shoes (soles suitable for Astroturf)  
Tennis shirts/tennis tops  
Tennis shorts/skirts/dresses  
Sports caps  
Track suits in cold weather  
Waterproof outerwear in wet weather

#### UNACCEPTABLE

Ridged or stud soled trainers  
Shoes/sandals  
Beach wear/T shirts  
Shirts/blouses/non-tennis T shirts  
Denim jeans/jackets  
Trousers/tailored trousers  
Combat/cargo pants  
Bermuda shorts  
Leggings  
Cycling shorts  
Football strips

**This Code will be kept under review. Any marginal issues will be decided by the Management Committee and any changes will be published on the Notice Board.**

#### EXCEPTION

**Mini Tennis Players and Junior Friday Club Players are exempt from the above code, except that they must wear \*Tennis Specific Shoes at all times on court.**

**Mini Tennis Members playing in a Junior League match should conform to the Dress Code.**

**ALL MEMBERS are requested to respect court courtesy and etiquette at all times.**

## **Bye-law No. 02**

### **VISITORS' COURT FEES**

**Visitors' Court Fees are payable daily** (currently £2.00 senior and £1.00 junior) and details entered on the Visitors' List, with the names of the responsible member and visitor.

## **Bye-law No. 3**

### **LOSTOCK LTC MEMBERS WAITING TO PLAY**

**When members are waiting**, players must come off court after a short set or 20 minutes (7 games in winter) spinning-in during Club/Social tennis sessions or, returning in rotation at other periods.

Singles players either make up to doubles sets or give way to doubles sets.

During peak Sat/Sunday afternoon hours, up to 3 courts are available specifically to senior members, with the remaining courts to junior and/or coaching, although no single group of 2 or 4 players may remain on court continuously while others are waiting. Juniors with senior status mix in with senior players. **Members are required to demonstrate a reasonable and flexible approach to specific circumstances applying at these times towards promoting high attendance and enjoyable tennis.**
